The Positives of Pokeweed

As most gardeners are aware, the native Pokeweed (*Phytolacca americana*), has a way of appearing in the most conspicuous and sometimes undesirable locations around the yard. Despite the drought this past year and the plants having since dried up, we chose not to remove them. The winter birds are still finding the dried fruit appealing to feast on this time of year! The overall habit of the plant itself can be formal and statuesque, especially when left with taller perennials whose height prevents the long, gangly stalks of the Pokeweed from falling over. The fruit is attractive to many species of birds from summer through fall and into the winter. The flowers are visited by hummingbirds and other beneficial pollinators. Please consider leaving a few Pokeweed in your landscape this year.







Thinking about Removing Invasives?

Familiarizing yourself with local invasives is important. Winter is a good time to remove them to make room in the spring for natives that need more room to thrive.
